RECIPE CORNER

Pumpkin Gnocchi in Sage Butter

Ingredients

1 ¹/₂ cups all-purpose flour ¹/₄ teaspoon salt ¹/₄ teaspoon pepper ¹/₈ teaspoon ground nutmeg 1 cup canned pumpkin 6 quarts water ¹/₂ cup butter, cubed 4 fresh sage leaves, thinly sliced 1 garlic clove, minced

Directions

- In a small bowl, combine the flour, salt, pepper, and nutmeg. Stir in pumpkin until blended. On a lightly floured surface, knead 10-12 times, forming a soft dough. Let rest for 10 minutes.
- Divide dough into four portions. On a lightly floured surface, roll each portion into a ¹/₂-inch-thick rope; cut into ³/₄-inch pieces. Press and roll each piece with a lightly floured fork.
- In a Dutch oven, bring water to a boil. Cook gnocchi in batches for 1-1¹/₂ minutes or until they float. Remove with a slotted spoon; keep warm.
- **4.** In a large heavy saucepan, melt butter over medium heat. Add the sage, garlic, and gnocchi; stir to coat.
